From Brenda, RCM:

The following two motions (9-3-23 and 9-4-23) were submitted at the September 2023 meeting but were not included in their entirety with the minutes from that meeting, so some areas/home groups did not have all the necessary information on which to vote. These two motions are presented in their entirety in <u>new business</u> and will be voted on at Region in March. I suggest homegroups review these motions in their entirety and then resubmit their votes at the February OVANA.

Motion 9-3-23: (ATRANA). The Across the Rivers Area Public Relations group is asking for a budget of \$1675 for a billboard in our area. The production part of the billboard is going to cost a total of \$175 for the vinyl wrap that will be displayed. The \$1500 will be used to pay for a 12 week duration of display. Attached is a breakdown of the options and cost as well as a possible design idea. The vinyl wrap will be ours to keep even after the 12 week period is up so that we can use it for future projects. The intent for the billboard is to carry the message of Narcotics Anonymous to the public. We intend to display our hotline phone number as well as our website to reach as many addicts in need as possible. We plan to carefully watch the traffic on our website and hotline while the billboard is displayed to gauge how effective our public relations campaign with the billboard will be. OVANA Public Relations Subcommittee Would like to request a total of \$735 for using in local public relations. The breakdown of the ask would be that we have:

- \$200 for business cards and flyers that contain the area helpline number. This is of paramount importance due to the area getting a new phone number
- \$70 for 3 4-tier acrylic info stands with cardholders that will be left and repeatedly filled with NA IPs in facilities such as treatment facilities, libraries, and jails
- \$65 for IPs that will fill all acrylic info stands for the remainder of the year.
- \$150 for NA Basic texts to be placed in public libraries, local jails, and halfway houses
- \$250 for promotional items that will be displayed on the Narcotics Anonymous booth at various recovery events to attract new members. OVANA has attended one event like this already this year with a plan to attend one more this October. We plan on these promotional items lasting through all events through 2024 due to minimum purchase requirements on custom promotional items. These items will contain our helpline number and may also be placed near info stands left in treatment facilities. These items could include but are not limited to
 - Magnets
 - Pens
 - Stress balls
 - Frisbees
 - Lanyards
 - Fidget Spinners
