The World Convention final report was released. The expense over income was \$995,897. As a result of this loss, the World Board has decided to not hold a convention in 2027. The future of the World Convention will be determined by the World Board and be revealed at a later date.

Kentuckiana Region will be hosting the Southern Zonal Forum Oct 24-26 at the Premier Best Western, in Louisville KY. The RD has reached out to the Louisville Area Activities Committee, and they will be hosting their Halloween Event at this function. Flyers will be available soon.
