


Sweet Surrender Homegroup Report-July 2025

Hello family, we are happy to report that Sweet Surrender is going strong and sharing experience, strength and hope every Tuesday at 7pm. We would like to extend sincere gratitude to the members of the Budget Ad-hoc committee for their service and the recent proposal submitted to Area and homegroups for approval. While Sweet Surrender voted “No” to the proposal, it generated valuable discussion amongst homegroup members and we would like to propose to the Ad-hoc committee several suggestions for revising the proposal.



1. Since this is a proposed policy change, it is important that the language of the new or amended policies be included for Homegroup approval.
2. The Fiscal year should be defined specifically. Currently the proposal states “March to March”. More accurate would be April 1-March 30 or March 1-February 28.
3. While the intent of including “Fixed Costs” as line items in policy in order to simplify the budget process makes sense, there are no guarantees that those fixed costs will remain consistent year over year. Website, mailbox etc can all increase (or decrease) from year to year. Having these fixed costs as Policy would require sending the policy back to homegroups for approval. Including all expenses in the Budget would only require one vote and would allow for change over time.
4. If the Ad-hoc committee believes there is strong reasoning for keeping these “fixed costs” in policy, then several options would allow a bit of flexibility.
  - a. Creating on “Budget” rather than having the line items within various Committee Policies would simplify any changes that needed to be voted on by homegroups. This policy could also include the new timelines and process for development of the annual budget.
  - b. Increasing the fixed line item dollar amounts by a small percentage (5-10%) would give ample room for any unexpected increases.
5. Another consideration that would require additional policy changes. Changing the Fiscal year to July 1-June 30 AND changing the Area Service commitments to April 1-March 30. This would allow:
  - a. Alignment of the fiscal year with many businesses/non-profit organizations.
  - b. Nominating and voting process for trusted servants in the early months of the year would encourage more participation in both willingness to serve and homegroup voting. Participation, voting etc. are more challenging during the months of November and December.

We greatly appreciate the careful thought and time the Ad-hoc Committee dedicated to Area and members in identifying the issues and solutions with the budget process. We look forward to seeing their work come to fruition. Several members of the homegroup would be willing to provide additional support to the committee should they want additional resources.


