I hope all is well.

I attended the Regional meeting on 10/05/25.

KRCNA has a current balance of \$29, 822.01. Region received reimbursement and the profits from the last convention. Total profits were \$9.357.09. \$5, 614.26 remained with region and \$3,742.83 (40%) going to World Service. Treasurer paid the yearly rent on the storage unit of \$720.00.

The motion to change the rotation passed. 502 area has not attended region in a long time.

After a long discussion on policy and procedure, letters of concern were sent, with no reply, 502 area was removed from rotation.

Rotation is as follows:

July – ATRA

September – PANA

November – OVANA


