Hello family,

- First Savings Bank was bought by First Merchants, so that is our bank now. The process to get online access was very smooth and seamless and the new debit card has activated. It must be updated on all auto-drafting spots such as the website (does anyone know any others?)
- I was able to deposit the cash and checks from March and April area which totaled \$395.
- We had the annual draft from the Website in April as well, totalling 152.51. Note that this is over the budget of \$150. Since this fixed expense had a 5% discrepancy on top then rounded to next 10, it seems like this was more like a \$20 a year increase or thereabouts.
 - Recommendation: Webmaster to look at bill to see why it went up followed by a policy update to make sure we have enough set aside in the future

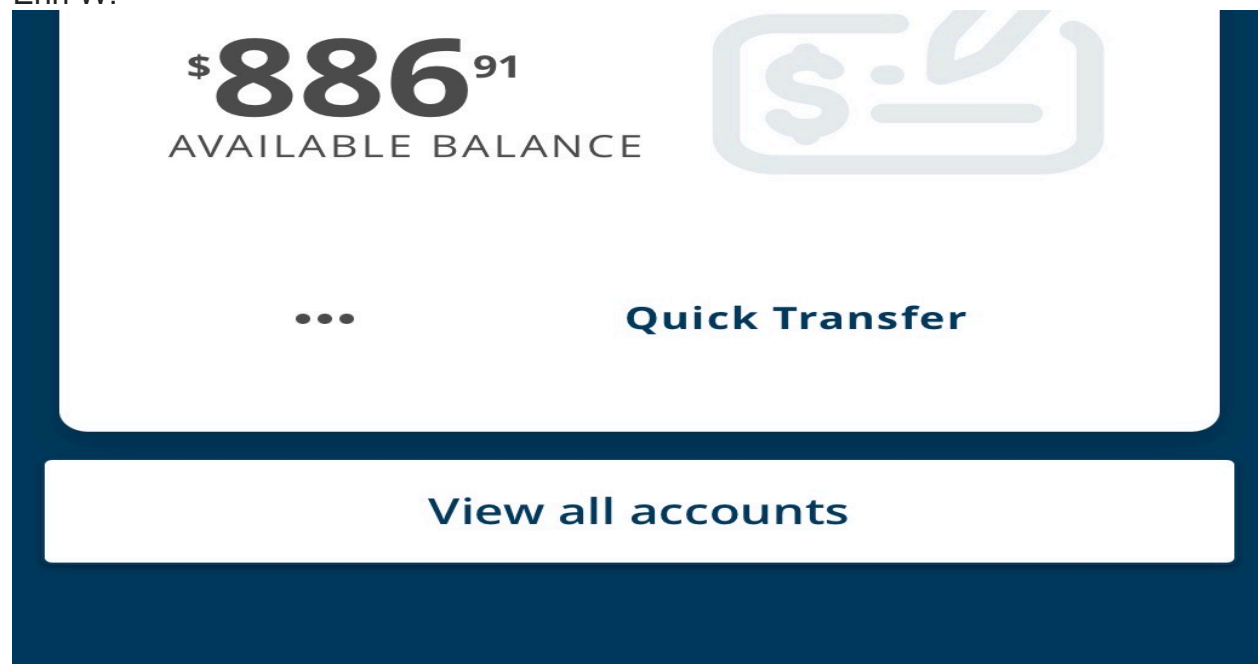
Literature:

ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER – QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

Purpose: Robert's Rules of Order provides a fair, organized process for conducting meetings and making decisions.

Basic Meeting Agenda 1. Call to Order 2. Roll Call/Establish Quorum 3. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes 4. Officer and Committee Reports 5. Old Business 6. New Business 7. Announcements 8. Adjournment

Making a Motion 1. Member obtains recognition from the Chair. 2. Member states: "I move that..." 3. Another member seconds the motion. 4. Chair restates the motion. 5. Members discuss the motion. 6. Chair calls for a vote. 7. Chair announces the result.

Common Motions

Main Motion Purpose: Introduce new business. Example: "I move to approve the 2027 budget."

Amend a Motion Purpose: Modify a pending motion. Example: "I move to amend the motion by changing the amount from \$5,000 to \$7,500."

Table a Motion Purpose: Temporarily postpone discussion. Example: "I move to table this motion until next month's meeting."

Call the Question Purpose: End debate and proceed to a vote. Requires a second and a 2/3 vote.

Adjourn Purpose: End the meeting. Example: "I move to adjourn."

Voting Methods • Voice Vote ("Aye" or "No") • Show of Hands • Roll Call Vote • Ballot Vote

Types of Votes Required • Majority Vote (>50%): Most routine business. • Two-Thirds Vote (2/3): Limiting debate, suspending rules, certain special actions.

Key Terms

Chair: Person presiding over the meeting. Motion: Proposal for action. Second: Indicates another member wishes to consider the motion. Quorum: Minimum number of members required to conduct business. Majority: More than half of votes cast. Amendment: Change to a motion.

Important Reminders • Only one person speaks at a time. • Discussion must stay focused on the pending motion. • Members address remarks through the Chair. • Personal attacks are not permitted. • Once a vote is taken, the decision stands unless reconsidered according to the rules.
